



In Spotlight: Project Nandini



To promote Menstrual Hygiene Management (MHM) and challenge the social stigma surrounding menstruation, we initiated Project Nandini in 5 Government Schools of Ludhiana (Punjab) in 2019. The response from schools was overwhelmingly positive, leading to the expansion of the project to include 19 government schools within a short period.



Encouraged by the success, we have now extended the project to the Baddi region in Himachal Pradesh and the Budhni region in Madhya Pradesh, encompassing 8 slums in addition to the existing 19 government schools and 7 villages. As of now, this program has positively impacted over 6,545 adolescent girls and provided menstrual hygiene education to 14,989 villagers.





Under the project, we organize informative sessions aimed at empowering young girls to understand the natural and biological aspects of menstruation, dispelling any prevailing myths. Furthermore, we have installed sanitary napkin vending machines in schools to ensure convenient and affordable access to hygienic sanitary napkins. Additionally, we have set up incinerators to facilitate the safe disposal of used sanitary napkins.




